Omahans chosen to co-chair Governor's Lecture

Omahans Angenette Meaney and Melissa Marvin will co-chair the planning committee for the 14th Annual Governor's Lecture in the Humanities, Nov. 4 at the Joslyn Art Museum.

The featured lecturer is Matt Miller, author of the recently "The Tyranny of Dead Ideas: Letting Go of the Old Ways of Thinking to Unleash a New Prosperity." Presented by the Nebraska Humanities Council (NHC), the University of Nebraska, and Valmont Industries, the evening lecture is free and open to the public.

Meaney and Marvin are members of the board of directors of the Nebraska Foundation for the Humanities.

Miller is a columnist at Fortune and an award-winning contributor to The Atlantic Monthly, the New York Times Magazine and many other publications. His 2003 book "The 2% Solution: Fixing America's Problems in Ways Liberals and Conservatives Can Love" was a bestseller. Miller hosts "Left, Right, & Center" on National Public Radio.

Miller was a White House Fellow from 1991 to 1992, serving as special assistant to the chairman of the Federal Communications Commission. From 1993 to 1995, he was a senior advisor in the Office of Management and Budget. Miller is a senior advisor to the global management consulting firm McKinsey & Co.
